I must be 13 years of age by Pilgrimage time and must be accompanied by an adult sponsor if under 18. (Any new pilgrim (regardless of age) will need a sponsor).

To sign up for the Pilgrimage is to commit myself to one year of prayer, service and fellowship within the Pilgrimage organization and my parish. Walking to Chimayo is but one highlight of my Pilgrimage with the Lord in this year.

I WILL NOT ride during the Pilgrimage (unless it is recommended by the Pilgrimage Leadership: Rector(a), or Spiritual Director). My case will be reviewed at the end of the day.

If I fall 1/4 mile behind the group, I will be picked up by the tail truck and given a ride. My case will be reviewed. It will be determined if I can or cannot continue. If I cannot do so, or if it is the opinion of the Pilgrimage Leadership: Rector(a), Spiritual Director, that I not be allowed to continue, I will be sent home. I may join the group at the Santuario on Saturday, walk into Santuario, receive cross and participate in the closing mass with my group.

I must attend ALL preparation meetings, unless excused. If you cannot attend, contact Fr. Ed or your Rector(a) prior to the meeting date(s). I must continue my Pilgrimage after arriving at Chimayo by involvement in Parish activity, Pilgrimage organization, or other Church participation.

I am required to participate in Holy Week services and other preparation walks. I must participate in preparation activities and "Post Chimayo" spiritual life.

I WILL NOT POSSESS or use illegal drugs or alcohol.

I will conduct myself in a Christian manner at all times, during my preparation, and during the Pilgrimage.

The Registration fee is NOT refundable.

I am required to complete at least a 20-mile practice walk at one time, prior to the June Pilgrimage.
